I coach a competitive fastpitch team and my assistant has coached a couple of baseball teams that have won national titles in their age division so we were looking for something that would accomplish two missions. First, I looked at BATA 2, which I liked a lot but when I was reading the manual it stated the machine couldn't be used in 100 degree heat and since we are in the south that was a deal killer. Other than that I loved the construction, the components, and the ability to convert from softball to baseball. Second we looked at the ATEC Casey Pro 3G and again was a very nice machine but the major drawback was that it was only baseball or only softball. The construction was very good but that one limitation removed it from the list. I have a JUGS so that was not a consideration at all. It is a very durable machine but not very accurate and it weighs a ton. So we come to the Ryan Express. The build on this machine is very solid. It comes with transport wheels so it easy to maneuver but be careful not to hit the ground with the throwing wheels because they can be damaged. It will throw real leather balls so you can use it for drills and hitting which is great because you can throw a whole lot more accurate than you can hit. It has three quick release adjustments so fine tuning is very easy and the handles have a ratched mechanism so tightening is really easy too.

It comes with plenty of assembly so if you like to put things together you will love it. It took me about an hour but I wasn't in a hurry and I wanted to make sure I did it right the first time. You will find several pieces where it is tight quarters and takes patience to get the nuts and bolts in the holes. I bought the softball kit separately so I installed it instead of the baseball legs. It is pretty heavy 95lbs so you may need some assistance with a couple of the steps. The nuts and bolts are metric so make sure you have them available. The instructions were very vague so you needed to think before you started tightening things down. Overall though not too difficult. I am very critical but with this it was an easy review. I hope this helps. For one, it is quite expensive; not when compared to other like models, but it is quite an investment for home use. And two, it only had one review. I had found it listed on several sites around the web but none of the sites really had customer reviews available. They also don't have very detailed images of the machine. The price was real close everywhere I shopped. I think I found only one site that had a lower price but there was a long lead time for delivery. I justified the expense by deciding that it will help both my boys with batting practice at home and once they're grown, I can probably sell it and at least get part of my investment back, or donate it to the school. Before buying the Ryan Baseball Pitching Machine, we had been using a Louisville Slugger, spring loaded pitching machine. The spring loaded machine works fine until your kids get up to the level where they're playing against kids pitching much faster than the machine can pitch which is probably around 14 years of age, and sometimes earlier. I have two boys who love playing baseball and my oldest, he is now playing high school ball, outgrew the Louisville Slugger a few years ago; my youngest will reach that point in the next couple of years.

I was mainly interested in the Ryan machine for my oldest son. He played his first season of high school baseball this past spring and went up against some kids throwing in the upper 80s and lower 90 MPH range and his whole team struggled to hit against these guys. My kids attend a private Christian school with almost nonexistent program budgets so they don't have a machine to practice with. And, much to my dismay, the coach didn't practice the kids enough hitting off of team or outside pitchers; so the kids basically had no experience hitting off pitches in the upper range that they went up against in their games. I'm hoping to correct that for my son before the next season. The machine itself seems to be well made. All of the parts seem to be very high quality. I like the solid wheels better than the inflatables I've used in the past. The documentation that came with the machine is okay when it comes to explaining how to use the machine; this info is also printed on the machine labels in table format; but the assembly part of the instructions was not all that great. It would help if they included images along with the step by step instructions. Luckily, there's not a whole lot to put together; mainly just the tripod and mounting the dolly wheels for moving it around. The machine portion comes preassembled. The machine is heavy; nothing that would trouble a capable adult male but it may be a little much for some women and most children. I would not allow children to set up and operate this machine unsupervised. Once assembled, it is very easy to maneuver by flipping it over onto the included and attached dolly wheels. A lot of machines I've used in the past use the pitching wheels like this for maneuvering; I rather like this design better. However, I was concerned that it might not roll well on our lawn; but it turned out to be a nonissue. It also stores well in the upside down position. We keep ours sitting that way in the garage.

If it takes up too much space, the legs of the tripod can be removed to reduce the space consumed. If you use this machine at the higher speeds, you'll probably want to invest in a decent backstop if you don't have something already to keep the missed balls from traveling too far. I have a couple of acres and all my neighbors do as well; so missed balls can travel a few hundred feet before stopping. That can make for a lot of ball shagging. A full batting cage would be preferable but that also adds a lot more expense to the setup. I opted for a decent backstop for now but hope to build out a full cage eventually. We have used this machine with regular baseballs and the hard rubber dimpled balls. I never thought I would prefer the dimpled balls to baseballs but they do actually work better with this machine. Baseballs work well with the machine as well but it will chew up the cheaper balls pretty quickly; plus they leave a white residue on the pitching wheels. Quality leather balls work well though. The dimpled balls are more consistent and less expensive as well. I think they make good practice balls but I still will use leather baseballs with it to get the full realistic effect. We haven't really used it to pitch anything but fastballs so far but it does that very well; as well as any of the Jugs machines I've used in the past. Unfortunately, we didn't get this machine in time for my oldest to

use it this year for his baseball season; but, we were able to work with my youngest a few times before his season ended and it seemed to help a lot. Im looking forward to using this machine a lot before the next baseball season starts. Excellent consistency in throwing both fastballs and curve balls for strikes. No worries about tire pressure since wheels are solid. I have only used the dimple balls in the machine and could not be happier with the results. The 5 yr warranty is a plus also. My son is 12 so we plan on using this machine through his high school years.

Im using a DEWALT DCB1800B Portable Power Station with 4 5Ah batteries to run it which is super convenient. Ive run it for over 2 hours so far with hardly any battery usage. Im using the Jugs Yellow Dimpled Baseballs which work well. Standard baseballs work but it tears them up so I highly suggest using pitching machine balls. Showing some wear now but still going strong. I havent replaced the wheel so it is starting to lose some of its zip. So much so that I started looking for a replacement wheel.

To my surprise a replacement wheel cost over half the price of a new machine. So now Im stuck between dishing out the money for a new wheel hoping the motor doesnt crap out, buying a new unit, or shelling out twice as much for a higher end machine. Knocking off a star from my initial rating as I consider it to be somewhat shady business to charge over half the price of the entire unit for a wear and tear replacement part. In the cage the machine is placed 40 from home plate. Machine accuracy is not perfect, but it is close enough that the batters can get in the box comfortably without fear of getting hit by a random ball. Notes. 1. The legs that the machine comes with are too short to be able to use a pitching screen. We simply made longer legs out of HD conduit. 2. The machine head does not pivot left to right. To change location inside or outside of the pitch you must lift the unit and reposition it. Luckily the unit is light enough. 3. The wheel is made from solid rubber so it does and will mark up any ball you feed it. Also overtime the wheel wear down. The wear rate was worse when we used real baseballs 4. Balls we started with real baseballs and the unit pitched them just fine. But as stated above the wear on the wheel was very noticeable. We switch to McGregor dimpled balls and are quite happy with the quality of the balls amd wear rate of the wheel. We highly recommend the McGregor balls. The price point is significantly cheaper than other brands allowing you to buy more. Higher quality than I expected. Seems solid and stable. Once I dialed it in I threw 10 pitches to make sure it was not inconsistent before I let my 7 year old give it a try, All were the exact same pitch with exact placement. He loved it and thinks hes in the majors now. Pop flies were a little harder I guess you need to place the front 2 legs on something to

increase the angle the highest regular setting only gets about 20 ft off the ground.

I could buy 34 of these for the same price as the higher priced popular models but if I covered them up you probably couldn't tell which pitch came from which machine. Very Pleased so far. The balls we use are leather covered baseball and softball and it pitches consistently right down the middle. The manual says to only use the dimple balls. I plan on buying some down the road. The conversion from baseball to softball only takes five mins. This machine saves my arm. Thanks for making a great product. Daughter age 10, son age 7. We don't bother switching baseball/softball feeder or leg adjustments; the height of the machine legs at "baseball height" is slightly above my waist I'm 5'9" so it's a reasonable simulation of pitch release height for my kids. We use the jugs sting free balls; very accurate if you use balls that at bought at the same time; if they were manufactured at a particular weight they will throw the same. Different weights by the gram will affect a low or high pitch, just like those Louisville Slugger UPM machines. Speed adjuster is very precise. Height controller also robust and easy. The machine doesn't "jump" after each pitch needing adjustments left and right. The black rubber wheel DOES leave black on the balls Jugs sting free so your bats WILL get black all over the barrel. A good thought the manufacturer employed was a thick metal guard just below the pitch exit point; it protects the motor from come backers. A lot of machines don't have this and the line drive will either hit the wheel ball flies in an uncontrollable direction or hit the motor and break it. For an fastball pitching machine for the backyard batting cage, I don't see any machine for a better value. I played D1 college ball in my day and none of us trained with a curveball machine. If you're looking for curveballs, use the slot hole wiffle balls and throw them live arm. In short, for a backyard batting cage, this is a great value.

It's used for about 8 hours a week run time for the past two months and no issues. We use it to break in new gloves, work on catching transferring drills, and just learning how to catch. Have fun! I play in a mens fastpitch softball league and we needed something to practice with. At proper distance, its quick but not quick enough so we just moved it forward a few feet and it did the trick.
